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NMBs AVAILABLES IN COLOMBIA

- Cisatracurium besylate 10mg/5mL vial
- Rocuronium Bromide 50mg/5mL
- Vecuronium Bromide 10mg
- Succinylcholine 1g/10mL

















KEY STRATEGIES

IDENTIFICATION

Include in high alert medication list.

PRESCRIBING AND DISPENSING

- Restricted to Intensive care units and operating rooms
- Availability of reversal agents



ADMINISTRATION

- Syringes labelling with Colorcoded in anesthesia
- Standardized concentration for countunous infusions.





LABELLING AND STORAGE

"High alert" auxiliary labels in products and storage compartments

PREPARING

Prefilled syringes Succinylcholine prepared by pharmacy (not commercially available)





MAIN GAPS



IMPLEMENTATION

Strategies are not uniformly implemented in hospitals. (Mainly JCI accredited institutions).



LEGISLATION

Absent warnings by the manufacturers "PARALYZING AGENT" as recommended by FDA)



DRUG SHORTAGES

- Risk of confusion
- Labeling in other languages*

*Covid-19



PREFILLED SYRINGES

 Lack of availability of commercially presentations.



NEXT STEPS



Develop a local survey on NMBs (Near miss, learned lessons, best practices).
